### 22<sup>nd</sup> Masters' International Speed Skating SPRINT CLASSICS 2020 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of January 2020 Max Aicher Arena Inzell / Germany

The competition is to be held in accordance with the following conditions of contest, the Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) at the 400 m covered standard speed skating track of the Max Aicher Arena (MAA) in Inzell on artificial ice. This competition is a regular event on the International Masters' Competition Calendar of the IMSSC.

#### 1. Distances

Ladies and Men 500 m, 1000 m / 500 m, 1000 m (sprint combination).

#### 2. Age Groups

The competitions take place in five year age groups as follows.

#### 3. Participants limitation

The competition is restricted to 120 skaters.

#### 4. Eligibility

To be eligible the skater must be member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU and must have a speed skating license of her/his federation.

## 5. Drawing, Classification

Drawing at Masters' International Sprint Competitions, including Masters' International Sprint Games, will be done according to ISU Rule 240 paragraph 4, with two exceptions:

- drawing of the third and fourth distance will be done based on the overall ranking (independent of age group) on the first respectively the second distance;
- all competitors will be admitted to the last distance.

## 6. Prices and Protocol

All participants, who skate successfully the four distances contest, obtain a certificate and protocol including end times. The Places 1, 2 and 3 of each 5 years ages group obtain a medal.
